SNOW TUBING \$15 per person (any age) OR \$5 for Pass Holders 2 hour pass

An exciting activity that requires no skill! Take a seat on our specially designed tubes and navigate down our 800 foot tubing park. Tube and rider are carried back to the top of the hill by our surface lift for multiple rides. Must be 42" tall.

CROSS COUNTRY SKIING \$20 per person OR \$5 for Pass Holders

Cross Country Skiing has been an event on the grounds of Mystic Mountain and Nemacolin since the 1970's. Our beautiful 1.5 mile trail takes advantage of The Links Golf Course and includes gorgeous views of the Laurel Highlands. Rental equipment is available at the Sundial Ski Lodge. Beginner and Intermediate lessons available weekends only.

SNOWSHOEING \$20 per person

Experience "flotation" this winter. Snowshoe rentals are available at the Sundial Ski Lodge. Our trails take advantage of The Links Golf Course and include gorgeous views of the Laurel Highlands. *Weather permitting.*

DOG SLEDDING \$150 per person / \$25 for second rider

Dog sledding at Nemacolin is an experience for the entire family. Our exclusive team of sled dogs call the Wildlife Academy home and are jumping at the chance to give everyone an encounter you won't ever forget. Experience consists of a 1/2 hour kennel tour and a 1/2 hour ride. Maximum combined weight of riders 275 pounds.



SKI & SNOWBOARD LESSONS

Mystic Mountain offers a variety of programs for all ages. The Snow Sports Academy employs the finest professional instructors from all over the world. Our instructors offer skiing, snowboarding, snowblading, and cross-country lessons.

The only way to learn a lifelong sport is by taking lessons. It is highly recommended for guests to book a lesson with one of our professionals. Private lessons are available every day Mystic Mountain is open by **ADVANCED RESERVATION**. Lessons are available for any age, but it is recommended that children be four years old.

1 hour private lesson: \$75 For each additional person \$15 per person (maximum of three)

2 hour private lesson: \$110 For each additional person \$30 per person (maximum of three)

Lessons must be scheduled in advance. **IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT A 100% fee is charged for no shows.** Cancellations are required 24 hours prior to the lesson to avoid the 100% cancellation charge.

MYSTIC MOUNTAIN SNOW CAMP Ages 4-12

The goal of Snow Camp is to instill confidence and a love of the sport of skiing to participants in the safest manner possible. We ensure everyone has a great time as they learn new skills in a "cool" social environment. Your youngster will be placed in a skill and age specific group that works best for him or her. The full-day program includes two on-the-snow group lessons in our one-of-a-kind Magical Land of Snow, a hearty skier's lunch, interactive indoor themed activities, as well as an introduction to our powerful skiing program, and a skiing report card to monitor the specific skills necessary to grow in the sport. Available each day Mystic Mountain is open. Special hours over the holiday season.

THE SLOPES OF MYSTIC MOUNTAIN

Beginner Area: This area is adorned with colorful animals and padded towers for the beginners to ski and snowboard around, under, and unfortunately sometimes over.

First Step: Large beginner bowl area. This slope is perfect for skiers and snowboarders who have progressed past the surface lift and are working on their turning abilities.

Geronimo: Our longest slope at one-half mile in length. By taking this slope, our guests are utilizing the easiest way to the bottom of Mystic Mountain. A laser-guided system was used to cut this beautiful trail, which is excellent for learning to ski or snowboard.

Grizzly Run: A step up from Geronimo with more thrilling terrain for those new intermediates. This slope also has an incredible view of the Laurel Highlands.

Nose Dive: Another gorgeous intermediate trail for those that can tackle Grizzly Run. This slope is a short, but steep descent, which exits onto Geronimo Slope.

Cliff Hanger: When your stomach meets your throat, you're halfway down this expert trail.

Showboat: This trail is located under the quad chair lift, which provides plenty of onlookers to watch skiers and riders devour this challenging expert trail.

Glade Run: This trail is located beside Showboat and provides aggressive tree skiing and riding for those experts daring enough to show off their skills.
